RME	Pupils who are highly able in RME are likely to: show high levels of insight into, and discernment beyond, the obvious and ordinary; make sense of, and draw meaning from, religious symbols, metaphors, texts and practices; be sensitive to, or aware of, the numinous or the mystery of life, and have a feeling for how these are explored and expressed; understand, apply and transfer ideas and concepts across topics in RME
	and into other religious and cultural contexts. In more general terms, they may also: have highly-developed skills of comprehension, analysis and research; show quickness of understanding and depth of thought.
